There are three major efforts paralleling and leading up to our 50<sup>th</sup> Reunion:

- 1. The first is "The 1970 Campaign for West Point" (the name approved for our Class gift effort), which has begun. The Class Gift Selection Committee, headed by classmate Joe Reeder, successfully recommended "The Class of 1970 Cyber Leaders Conference", a \$2.5M endowment to sponsor an annual gathering of the minds at USMA centering around the ever growing challenges of cybersecurity. - 2. The second effort is 50<sup>th</sup> Year Legacy Yearbook, headed by our 1970 Howitzer Editor Wally Kaine kainej@me.com and his team. The plan is to publish a Howitzer like product around our 50th Reunion time period that captures the various class activities over the last 50 years and provides individual summaries. Each class member will be asked to provide a write up with photographs that tells what they have been up to for all these years. We will also get this information for all deceased classmates. The Class of 1969 produced a fabulous product. If you are near any member of that class, ask to see it and it will really stimulate you. Collecting (and prodding) classmates will require some help, so Wally is asking for volunteers to be Cadet Company and Regimental reps. Their responsibilities will be to assist anyone who has questions and coordinate/follow-up on individual write ups and photos. - 3. The third effort, ongoing for a few years since when USMAPS 2016 started, is our *Affiliation with USMA 2020*. The goal of the 50 Year Class Affiliation is to participate in all the major activities of USMA Classes 50 years apart, and so far we have been successful with USMA 2020. The next major Affiliation Activity is **Inspiration to Serve** (August 19, 2018).

This is a relatively new ceremony for the Cows. As you recall, once you begin your second class academic year, you incur a service commitment. In an effort to demonstrate the significance of this commitment leading to lifelong service to the nation, the 2nd Class affirms their commitment in an **Affirmation Ceremony**, held the night before the fall academic semester starts. The Commandant will address the cadets as the first speaker; Classmate Jim Lovelace has tentatively agreed to be our guest speaker. Immediately following the addresses, the Commandant will administer the affirmation oath, and then our class will present a joint class coin (our crest on one side, Class of 2020 on the other) to each 2020 member. This is an extremely meaningful and moving ceremony.

Our goal is to have a rep from each of our cadet companies at the Affirmation Ceremony—'69 was able to pull this off last August and we need to follow their lead. Since this ceremony is conducted at night, it would likely require an overnight stay, although some involved with other class ceremonies left after the event. Chip Leonard is heading our efforts for this event; he needs many more Cadet Company Representatives to make this great 50 Year Affiliation event a success.
